Selecting coaches is a time-consuming endeavor with the committee spending as much time as necessary to find the most qualified and capable individual for a particular team.

All members of a Coaching Staff (Head Coach, Assistant Coach, Trainer, and Manager) must ultimately be approved by the WMHA Board of Directors.

Coach Certification Requirements:

AAA Coaches applying for U10 and U13 teams must have or be willing to acquire a minimum of **D1 certification** (2 day training course).

AAA Coaches applying for U14 or U18 teams must have or be willing to acquire the **HP1** certification (1 week training course).

All Coaches require their Respect-In-Sport, Gender Identity Course, as well as a current Vulnerable Sector Check/Police Check and Annual OHF Declaration.
